ABOUT KNIGHTS BRIDGE

Founded in 2006, the Knights Bridge Vineyard is nestled in the undeveloped west side of Knights Valley. Inspired by the rugged beauty of the region, Kelley and Jim Bailey built Knights Bridge Winery with the goal of producing truly profound wines and sharing this remarkable place with guests. Designed by renowned architect Howard Backen and completed in mid-2021, the distinctive design and thoughtful construction are perfectly in sync with the pristine landscape.

WINEMAKER

Winemaker Derek Baljeu earned both his BS and MS in Viticulture and Enology from UC Davis before joining Knights Bridge in 2019. His philosophy is simple: allow each vintage and vineyard block to speak for themselves. By balancing precision with restraint, Derek crafts wines that are vibrant, expressive, and built to age.

2024 ESTATE SAUVIGNON BLANC

The 2024 vintage benefited from abundant winter rainfall, an early growing season, and warm summer days followed by a long, even harvest, producing exceptional concentration and freshness. Estate-grown fruit from two vineyard blocks was native fermented and aged nine months in a combination of concrete eggs, stainless steel eggs, and French oak. Concrete builds mineral depth, stainless steel preserves purity, and oak adds subtle texture, creating a Sauvignon Blanc with bright citrus, white flowers, oyster shell minerality, and remarkable energy. Our commitment to sustainability extends beyond the vineyard. Through thoughtful farming, responsible business practices, and long-term stewardship of the estate, Kelley and Jim Bailey are preserving Knights Bridge for future generations while producing wines of exceptional quality.

ULTRA-PREMIUM SAUVIGNON BLANC

Despite fluctuations and challenges in the broader wine market, Sauvignon Blanc continues to shine, steadily growing in both sales value and volume as consumers seek fresh, food-friendly wines. Growth in the ultra-premium category is driven by a focus on single-vineyard sourcing, barrel fermentation, lees aging, and styles that feature deep, concentrated fruit. Leading producers achieve balance between lively acidity and greater complexity, texture, and aging potential. Knights Bridge Pont de Chevalier Sauvignon Blanc is an excellent value in this category, with 100% estate-grown and organically farmed fruit.
